ODDS AND ENDS

Some of the Hill 'N' Dale highlights from 2007 include-

Sales graduates-

- ❑ **MARYFIELD**, 1st Ballerina S. **G1** as well as 1st in the inaugural Breeders Cup Filly and Mare Sprint.
- ❑ **JAMBALAYA**-1st Arlington Million H. **G1**, 1st Gulfstream Park B.C. Turf **G1**.
- ❑ **DAAHER**-1st in the Hill 'N' Dale Cigar Mile **G1** etc.
- ❑ 4 Hill 'N' Dale Toronto Sales yearling graduates won Woodbine 2 year-old stakes in 2007. In addition, Giquere and Sebastion's Song, both 2 year-old colts, were among the most impressive maiden special weight winners in the country.

Racing Success-

- ❑ 1st and 3rd place finishers of the Breeders Cup Juvenile Fillies S. **G1 (INDIAN BLESSING and Backseat Rhythm)** were both foaled at Hill 'N' Dale Kentucky. **Backseat Rhythm** was also bred by Hill 'N' Dale Kentucky and is by Hill 'N' Dale sire **EL CORREDOR**.
- ❑ Hill 'N' Dale Kentucky's racing success included **G1** winner **DREAM RUSH** and multiple stakes winning millionaire **SOMETHINGABOUTLAURA**.

STALLIONS, SALES AND MORE

❑ **LEONATUS ANTEAS**-2006 Canadian 2 year-old Champion Colt, "LEO" was runner up for a Sovereign Award as Canada's top 3 year-old. **LEONATUS ANTEAS** is by Hill 'N' Dale sire **STORMY ATLANTIC** and was purchased by Donato Lanni, director of bloodstock services at Hill 'N' Dale.

❑ Freshman sire **VINDICATION** has had a terrific start to his stud career. By the end of 2007 he was represented by 19 winners including Graded stakes winner **MORE HAPPY**. **VINDICATION** has already had 2 more impressive winners in 2008.

❑ 3 of the top 8 polytrack sires of 2007 stand at Hill 'N' Dale Kentucky-**EL CORREDOR**, **MUTAKDDIM** and **STORMY ATLANTIC**.

❑ **Tip Toe Annie**, a 5 ³/₄ length Maiden Special Weight winner became Kinshasa's first stakes horse-2nd beaten a head in the \$150,000 Ontario Lassie-WOX.

❑ **IRISH CHERRY**, dam of **G1** winners **SPUN SUGAR** and **DAAHER**, was sold by Hill 'N' Dale at the recent Keeneland January Sale for a **sales topping** \$2,700,000.

❑ **STORMY ATLANTIC** and **MUTAKDDIM** were among the leading sires in North America while **THEATRICAL** sired 2 more **G1** winners (lifetime total of 21). **VINDICATION** was among the leading freshman sires of 2007 by winners & earnings.

4 NEW STALLIONS TO HILL 'N' DALE KENTUCKY-

❑ **CLOSING ARGUMENT**-A graded stakes winner that was a very brave 2nd in the Kentucky Derby **G1**. **CLOSING ARGUMENT** has been very well supported at stud thus far and is very strong conformationally. Lifetime-9-3-3-2 \$986,984.

❑ **MR. SEKIGUCHI**-\$8,000,000 yearling. By **STORM CAT** out of a **G3** stakes winner from the immediate family of **A.P. INDY**. Was talented enough to win 2 of 4 lifetime starts while finishing 2nd the other 2 times.

❑ **SEEKING THE BEST**-A beautifully bred Group winner by **SEEKING THE GOLD** (sire of sires including leading sire **MUTAKDDIM**). **SEEKING THE BEST** is inbred 6x6 to the Blue Hen mare **LA TROIENNE**.

❑ **SHAKESPEARE**-A brilliant racehorse that won 6 of 7 lifetime starts. In 2007, after a lengthy absence, **SHAKESPEARE** won impressively at Saratoga and then won the Woodbine Mile **G1** in dominating fashion.

CANDY RIDE- (RIDE THE RAILS/CANDY GIRL by CANDY STRIPES). Undefeated, extremely athletic, multiple **G1** winner, NTR Hollywood Park, world record miler-1:31 flat, 123 Beyer, Champion... First foals to run in 2008.

CLOSING ARGUMENT- (SUCCESSFUL APPEAL/MRS. GREELY by MR. GREELY). **GSW**, 2nd in the Kentucky Derby. Very impressive physically. First foals are yearlings of 2008. Very well supported!

EL CORREDOR- (MR. GREELEY/Silvery Swan by SILVER DEPUTY). **G1** winning son of MR. GREELY. Graded stakes performers in every crop. **EL GATO MALO-1st** San Rafael **G2** (SA) in 2008.

GRAND REWARD-STORM CAT/SERENA'S SONG by RAHY. Dam won over \$3,200,000 and is off to a brilliant start as a producer. **GRAND REWARD** is a great physical and a graded stakes winner.
