VINDICATION-1st TIMERS AT DEL MAR, SARATOGA-

With first foals 2 year-olds of 2007, **VINDICATION** is off to a very promising start. **Galiano** became the first winner for the Eclipse Award-winning 2 year-old breaking his maiden at first asking at Lone Star Park by 4 lengths. **Galiano** later became the first stakes horse for **VINDICATION** placing third in the Minstrel S. **VINDICATION** has also had first out winners at Woodbine, Del Mar and Saratoga (Sargent Seattle). Sargent Seattle was a 6 length winner at the Spa finishing just 1/5 of a second off of the track record. Blackberry Road, a 2 year-old half brother to **VINDICATION** (by **GONE WEST**), recently broke his maiden at Churchill Downs (MSW).
